As we get closer and closer to the taking off of this physical creation, we all get more and more impatient with the wiles of the Devil.

The real truth of the matter is this: The only one that will satisfy us completely is Yahshua the Messiah, our true husband and all others will fall short in one way or another. Paul put it this way: I wish you were as I am (he had no need for a woman as he was a eunuch and therefore could devote all effort to the ministry) but, never the less if you do marry, you do not sin.

Just don't push anything on any into anything in a hurry when it comes to a physical relationship and Yahweh will see to it that all things work out for your own good even though sometimes it may not seem like it at the time. Later, you will see where he had the whole situation under control at all times.

Keep in class and try to leave the flesh at home. When you find that you are bothered by the physical, think back to the Pentecost and the children of Israel and pretty soon the physical problem will just seem to pass away. Paul said that he rejoiced that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory that shall (very soon) be revealed in us.
